“Words Your Mother Taught You” Moment for Mission

What words did your mother teach you? After all, Mothers *are* our first teachers. They instill in us qualities that become part of the fabric of who we are. The words we learn from them resonate in our very being.

My mother taught three special words: **FAITH, SERVICE and LOVE.**
